Are you curious about new teaching methods, materials and ideas?
You would like to exchange ideas and experience with other teachers in the Danube region?

We are offering teachers in the Danube region the opportunity to upgrade their teaching methods and use web-based teaching materials in the age of ICT.

The aim of the eSchool4S project is to create a **multi-national and multi-level network** involving stakeholders in the education sector, teacher training institutions, schools, teachers, and classes in the joint development of testing, demonstration and dissemination of innovative e-teaching concepts for secondary schools in the Danube region.

In this phase we have **completed some lessons** and we would like to **share** it with the teaching community.

The overall theme of the web lessons is **Sustainable development** and all its dimensions – environmental, economic and social. The aim is to raise awareness of the most pressing global issues; their interconnectedness as well as the situation on regional and local levels. The project contributes towards the education for sustainability. The lessons are uploaded on the Moodle platform and this is an opportunity for all teachers to start using it.

You are **invited to participate in the training** and to provide your feedback on the steps you will take:

The work will start beginning of September and continue until the middle of October.

You will be expected to complete one assignment by yourself: a **lesson outline** in which you will shortly describe (up to one page) how you have used the materials available at the Moodle platform (which we will introduce to you to in the training process).

All successful participants will be awarded the **eSchool4s certificate**.

Your help will be very appreciated and your feedback will help us improve the materials and the training in the Moodle. And you can continue to use the materials, to revisit the training and materials on how to use Moodle and to communicate with your colleagues!



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How will the teacher training look like?

The teacher training will be organized in 3 simple steps:

1. 1st Questionnaire

In this first step, you will **register** at the eSchool4S Moodle page: <http://moodle.eschool4s.eu/login/index.php> to gain access to the initial questionnaire. This questionnaire is available under the **Teacher's corner** course.

To help you with the process of registration, we have prepared simple instructions which you can read or download – click [here](#).

This **questionnaire** is designed to learn more about you, your teaching methods and needs, etc. It will not be difficult or time consuming to complete!

The questionnaire is available and we would appreciate it if you could fill it out by September 25th.

2. How to use Moodle?

a) We will organize a **webinar** (an on-line seminar) in which we will teach you how to use Moodle and the teaching materials on sustainability issues in the Danube region prepared for you. This webinar will be recorded and uploaded so you don't have to worry about missing it or not immediately understanding all parts. You can always come back and refresh your knowledge.

This webinar will be held on October 1st, at 18:00.

b) After attending the webinar you will be asked to complete the **2nd questionnaire** so we can see how you managed.

Teachers will have their own special corner on the Moodle platform: there you will find instructions, all relevant documents and a teacher's forum in which you can engage with other teachers or partners from eSchool4S project.

3. Use the Moodle and tell us about it!

a) After you got to know Moodle, you are free to **use** eSchool4s Moodle course according to your needs. If you experience any kind of problem, please contact the local project partner and they will help you out (in local language)!

During this step you will prepare a **lesson outline**. A lesson outline is a simplified lesson plan: you do not need to assign time slots to activities in a class, simply list them (and the desired outcome) – up to 1 page. We will give you more detailed instructions on its form.



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b) On October 15th another **webinar** will be organised to gather all the teachers and allow them to exchange impressions on the training, useful tips and tricks, practical knowledge etc. This will be an opportunity to show your lesson outline!

c) After the webinar, the **3rd questionnaire** will be available. This questionnaire will gather your feedback on the training process and will help us understand what needs to be done to optimise it.

Now that you are done – a reward!

Every teacher who finishes all 3 stages of the training will become an **eSchool4s teacher/tutor**, with a certificate to show. The certificates will be sent to you in a **pdf** form via e-mail, and in a printed version to the adress of your school (**by post**) by the end of October.
